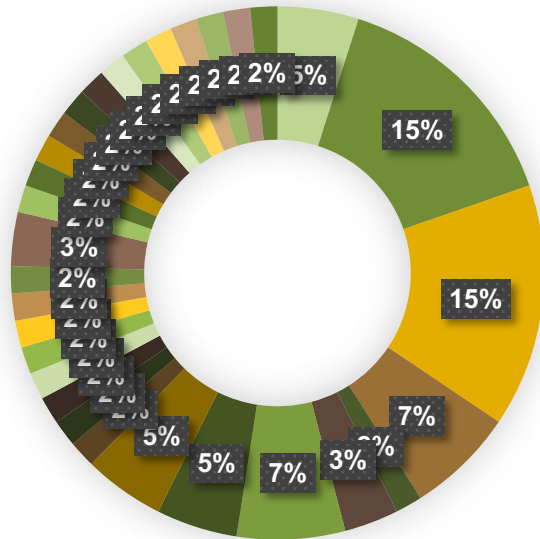

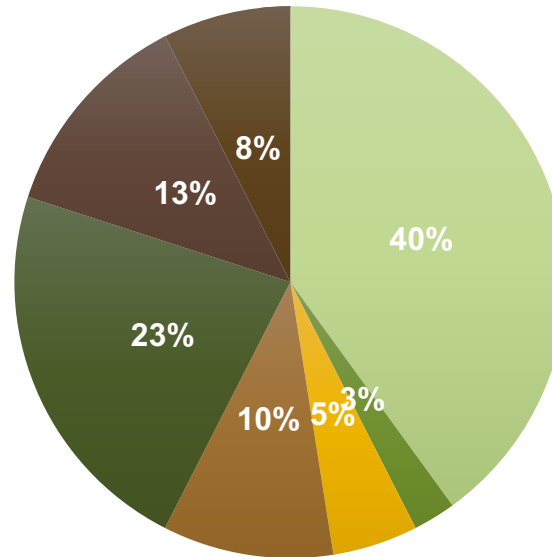

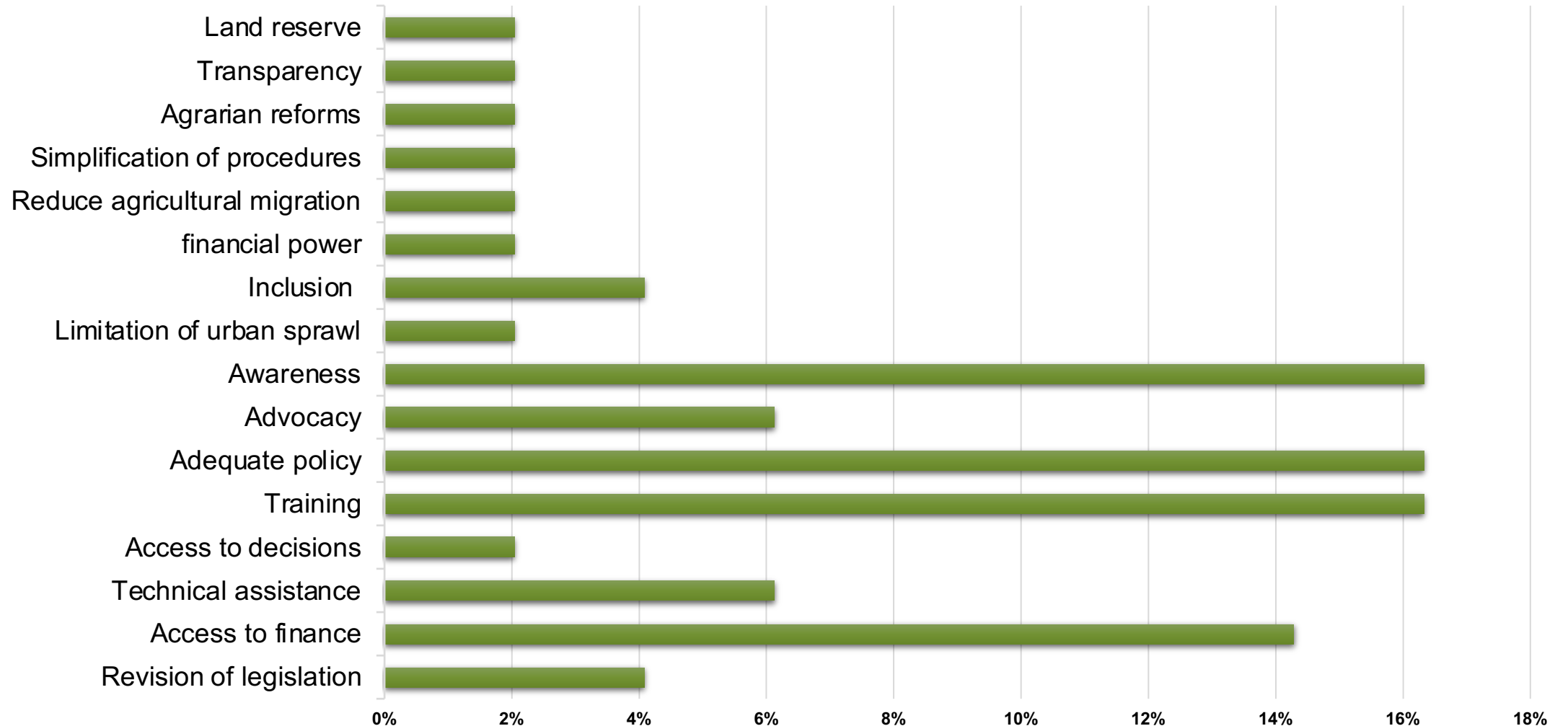

Outcomes

- **a study of barriers** that youth face when accessing secure land rights
- Data will be able to be used **by the Governments and others multi-stakeholders**
- Data will be used by **donors**
- Availability of **disaggregated data** by age, gender, socio-economic status, family status, urban/rural location and language across Africa.
- **Publish the report** : Publication of this report will facilitate communication and awareness raising that will strengthen the political knowledge and capacities of those working in the youth and land governance spheres, both within Benin's governments and universities, and among international donors. This research hopes to spark an even broader and more collaborative research agenda on these issues in partnership with other leading organizations.
