1. Objectives of the platform

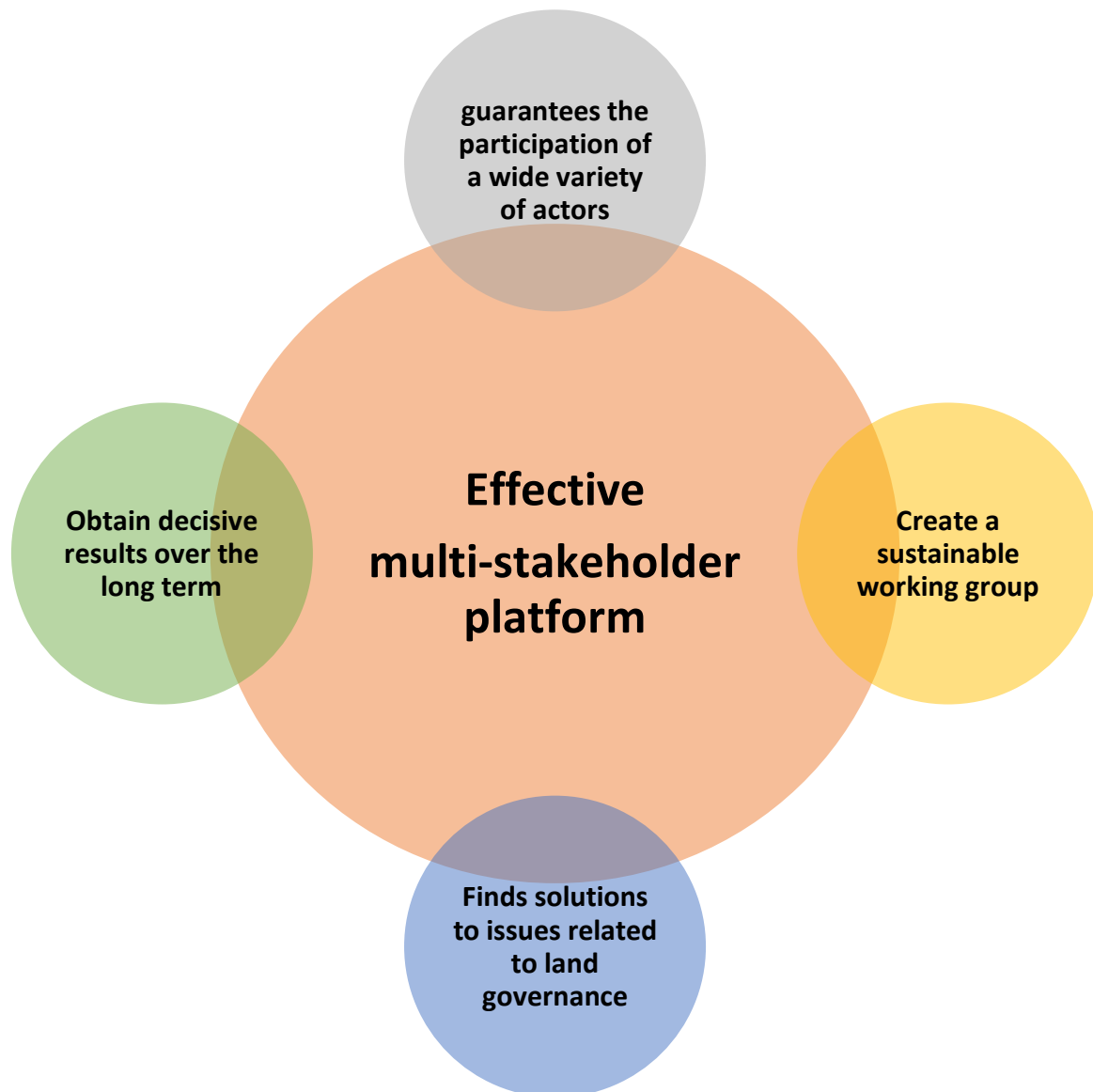
The platform's main objective is to put young people at the centre of land and natural resource governance in Africa. To this end, it envisages:

- Provide a multi-agency coordination mechanism to organize, connect and mobilize youth engagement and representation in land governance processes at all levels in Africa.
- Strengthen youth leadership and organizational capacity to engage and influence land governance processes in Africa;
- Bridging the knowledge gap through the development of a strategy to produce and disseminate data informed by ILC training sessions on data produced by youth and resulting from youth indicators on land governance.
- Provide a framework for political dialogue among young people and, open to the different decision-makers of the continent, including the private sector;
- Promote and advance gender justice with a particular focus on the land rights of women and indigenous communities.

2. Platform Vision

The platform is open to young African leaders working in the field of land governance, either as representatives of youth organizations working in this field, either as representatives of NGOs and grassroots organizations working in this field, such as farmers' organizations, Indigenous Peoples' organizations, women's organizations, to name a few. The platform is also open to young researchers working on land issues or related topics. Moreover, as can be seen in the figure below, this multi-stakeholder platform should make it possible to achieve a number of indicators.

3. 2024 Business Plan
