Overview about the Forum

The Ministry of Community Development, Gender, Women and Special Groups in collaboration with the National Council of Non-Governmental Organizations (NaCoNGO) organized an Annual Forum for Non-Governmental Organizations took place from 4th to 6th September, 2024 at the Jakaya Kikwete Convention Centre in Dodoma City. Mr. Ihucha-YILAA TZ officer was appointed to represent YILAA at the forum.

The objective of the forum was to build a common understanding of the coordination and management of Non-Governmental Organizations, to discuss the contribution of Non-Governmental Organizations to National Development, to identify how the activities of these Organizations can be aligned with National plans, and to strengthen the relationship between the Government and these Organizations. The motto of the meeting was **“Non-Governmental Organizations are Important Stakeholders, Let’s Involve Them to Strengthen Good Governance.”**

- The ceremony also had entertainment sessions, guests visiting exhibition booths where final remarks and closing done by Honorable Dr. Dotto M. Biteko, the Deputy Prime Minister and Minister for Energy as Guest of Honor.

Recommendations:

This is by implementing the following, the NGO sector can continue to play a vital role in addressing societal challenges and contributing to the sustainable development of nations;

1. Continued collaboration: The government and NGOs should maintain ongoing collaboration to ensure effective coordination and support for NGO activities.
2. Policy development: The government should develop and implement policies that support the growth and sustainability of the NGO sector.
3. Funding mechanisms: The government and private sector should explore innovative funding mechanisms to support NGO programs and initiatives.
4. Capacity building: NGOs should invest in capacity building to strengthen their organizational and Operational capabilities.
5. Technology adoption: NGOs should leverage technology to improve their efficiency, effectiveness, and reach.
6. Advocacy and awareness: NGOs should continue to advocate for their role in national development and raise awareness about their contributions.
7. Evaluation and monitoring: NGOs should implement robust evaluation and monitoring systems to measure the impact of their programs and initiatives.

Conclusion:

The ANGOF 2024 conference was a successful event that brought together key stakeholders from the NGO sector, government, and private sector. The Forum provided a platform for discussion for both challenges and opportunities, collaboration and intensive networking, and knowledge-sharing on critical issues related to the role and contributions of NGOs to national development.
