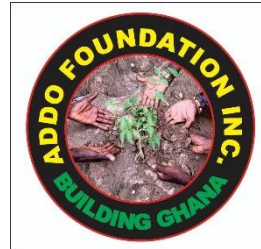

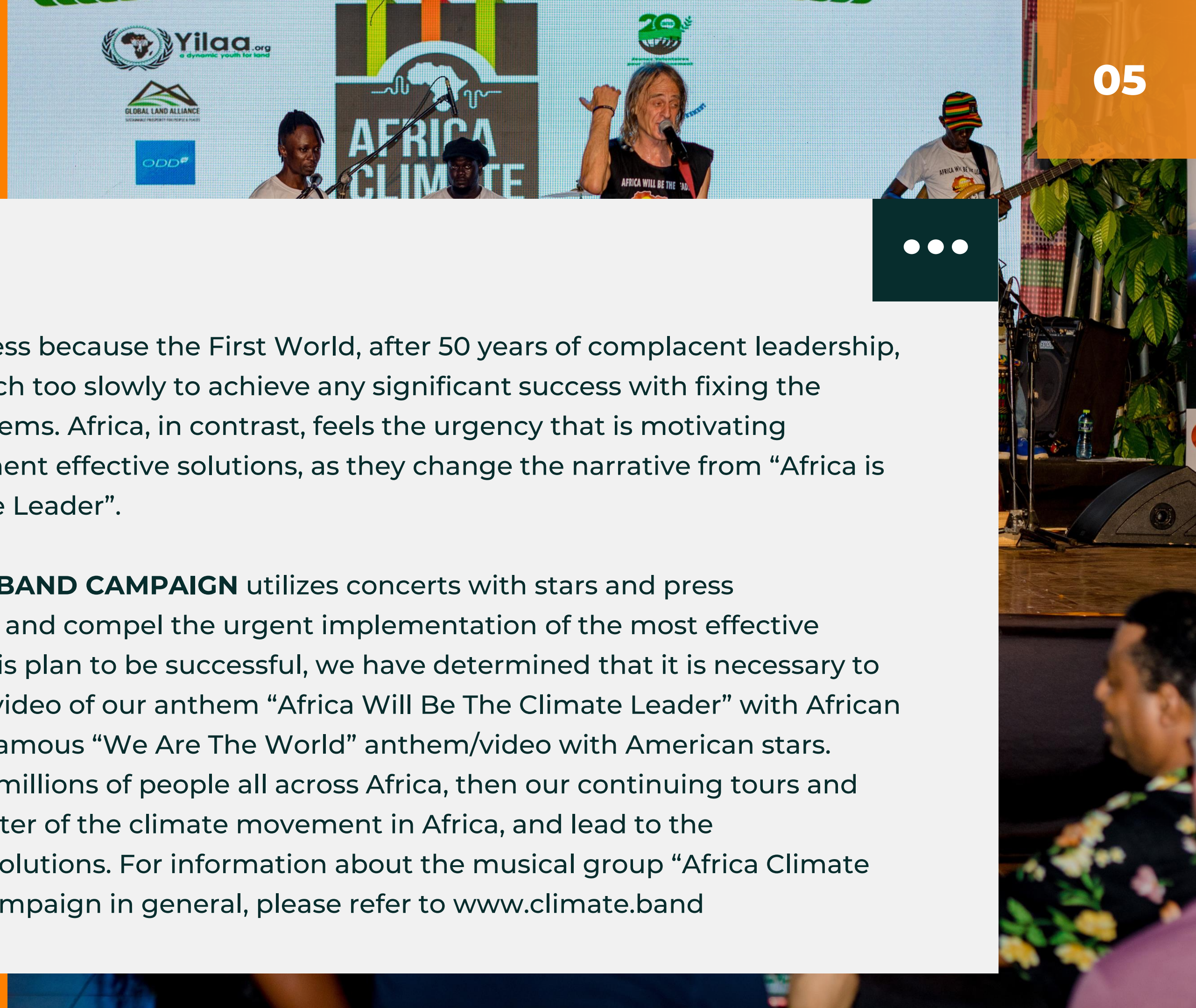


Background

Currently most of the Climate Movement is pursuing the old paradigm solution called "Emissions Reduction" which was reasonable 40 years ago, but today is no longer a real solution because emissions only add 1% annually to the greenhouse effect, and therefore reducing emissions does almost nothing in any relevant time frame to remove the cause of today's problem. The amount of heat trapping gases in the atmosphere are today already lethal, and they will be there for one thousand years destroying us if we do not remove them.

Africa is poised to implement the new paradigm solutions based on nature restoration. These solutions have the capacity to restore a proven safe climate by 2050.





Africa is the key to success because the First World, after 50 years of complacent leadership, has proven to move much too slowly to achieve any significant success with fixing the existential climate problems. Africa, in contrast, feels the urgency that is motivating the continent to implement effective solutions, as they change the narrative from “Africa is a Victim” to “Africa is the Leader”.

The **AFRICAN CLIMATE BAND CAMPAIGN** utilizes concerts with stars and press conferences to promote and compel the urgent implementation of the most effective climate solutions. For this plan to be successful, we have determined that it is necessary to create a popular music video of our anthem “Africa Will Be The Climate Leader” with African stars, analogous to the famous “We Are The World” anthem/video with American stars. With this video seen by millions of people all across Africa, then our continuing tours and events will be at the center of the climate movement in Africa, and lead to the implementation of the solutions. Project Proposal

We have scheduled a live concert in Accra, Ghana, on Sunday, August 4th. **The performance by the African Climate Band (joined by 4 African stars)** of our anthem “Africa Will Be The Climate Leader” in front of a large crowd of viewers will be filmed by our professional video team. From this material, plus other material sent from additional African stars singing "cameo" lines remotely, we will create a top-level music video that will be promoted all across Africa and the world.

We will edit this material into a state-of-the-art music video. Then we will do all the promotion necessary such that every country in Africa will see and hear it in 2024. Worldwide, we will also promote it, but not as fully as in Africa.*

We plan a special screening of our video at the United Nations Climate Conference "COP29" in Baku, Azerbaijan in November 2024.



Project Objectives

General objective

Solve the three main problems soon to be facing Africa:

- 1) Air temperatures too hot for people to work outside;
- 2) Weather too hot for farms to produce food;
- 3) Too much acid in the ocean for fish to exist.

Specific objective 1

Create a video/anthem to be famous all across Africa, because this will mean our continuous campaign of concerts and press conferences can be held in large, impressive venues with a lot of media coverage.

Specific objective 2

This will lead to a mass movement of Africans to demand implementation of the specific solutions.



Specific Solutions



The African Climate Band Campaign is bringing to the table up-to-date modern solutions, focusing on Ocean Restoration which quickly, safely, cheaply and in an eco-friendly way removes enough greenhouse gases to provide a proven safe environment. Ocean Restoration involves the nature-based restoration of ocean ecosystems by **100 fishing villages around the world, starting in Africa.** This very quickly and inexpensively brings plankton back to its historically normal levels of health and abundance. Consequently, by their natural process of photosynthesis, the restored plankton will swiftly remove enough CO₂ from the atmosphere to restore worldwide a safe proven climate by 2050. This same restored plankton also solves ocean acidification by neutralizing the acidic molecules currently threatening all ocean life.

The proposing organization



Youth Initiative for Land in Africa (YILAA), is an international non-profit organization with its headquarters in the Republic of Benin (West Africa) that promotes and defends the land rights of youth and women in Africa. It has focal points in 25 countries across Africa working and advocating for youth land governance in Africa. It has been accredited by the UNCCD, UNFCCC, Global Soil Partnership and is currently a member of International Land Coalition. YILAA is the first organizer of the International Youth and Land Governance Conference (CIGOFA). YILAA strives to promote gender equality and women's rights through continental initiatives and other high-level political dialogues across the world. The Youth Initiative for Land in Africa (YILAA) was formed in accordance with the law 1901 which relates to; the constitution and regulation of Associations, the declaration of the Heads of State and Government of the African Union on land issues and the youth. Its main headquarters are in Benin (Porto-Novo).

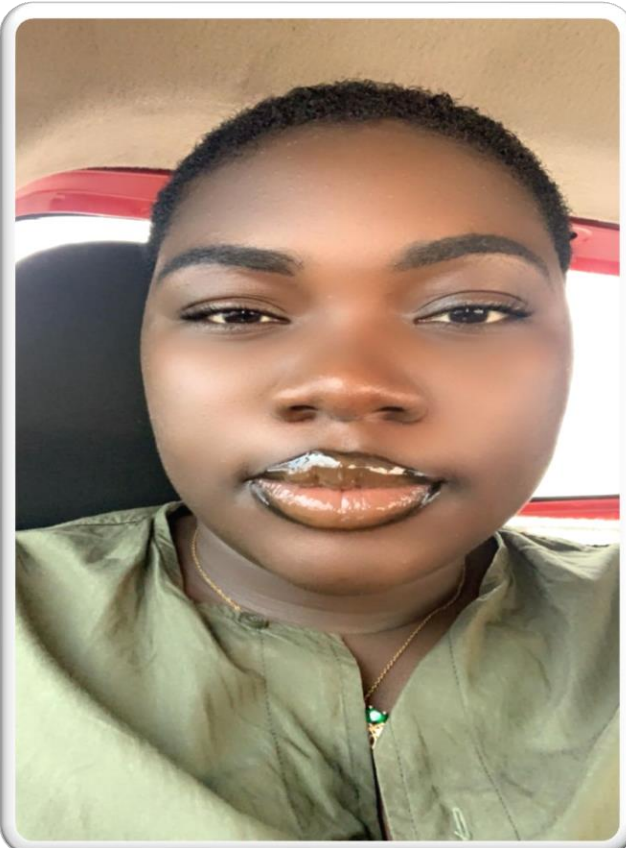
